### **REQUIRMENTS**

- All participants must be fit tested on the first night of class regardless of prior fit testing.
  - Bring the SCBA mask you will be using during the class
  - UC Fire Marshall Office will perform fit testing during the lecture.
- All participants WILL be clean shaven during the entire class. Per OSHA and NFPA regulations.
- All participants must have a signed release form from the FIRE CHIEF of their department showing proficiency in all 11 NFPA 1403 classes. Classes are listed at the bottom of this page.
- Any participant who is still in high school must have a letter from their parents acknowledging participation in the IDLH atmosphere.
- Any student under the age of 17 will NOT be allowed to participate in the class.
- Each member must bring to class each day the following:
  - Fully compliant SCBA with spare cylinder
  - In date and compliant full PPE
- This is a LABOR INTENSIVE course. Hydrate, hydrate, hydrate.
- Come prepared to work hard each time the class meets. Participation is mandatory.
- Failure to follow the requirements will be grounds for dismissal from the class.

- In compliance with 80% attendance, any time that **MUST** be missed must be discussed with the instructor in charge on the first night of class. It is **HIGHLY** advised not to miss any of the class as there are many objectives to meet. Certain dates will be mandatory.
