

Terms and Conditions of Financial Aid

Students receiving financial aid must:

- Meet current Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards as published in the college catalog, handbook and website;
- Only register for classes that are required for their financial aid eligible program of study;
- Meet class attendance requirements;
- Keeping the Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs informed of current residence, phone and email contact information;
- Notify the Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs of any additional aid resources that may increase or decrease financial need;
- Allow the Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs to make necessary corrections to FAFSA applications;
- Agree that financial aid awards will be applied to their college account to satisfy current year educational expenses, bookstore charges and any other necessary expenses;
- Understand that all awards are based on adequate funds being available to the college from supporting agencies and inadequate resources may result in an adjustment or loss of award;
- Allow scholarship and grant awarding agencies access to awardee information;
- Understand that financial aid will only provide funding for a maximum of 30 credit hours of developmental course work;
- Drop or withdraw from classes they do not intend to complete by the published deadlines;
- Understand that withdrawing from a class counts the same as a failing grade for financial aid purposes and SAP calculations.
