- ❖ Appeals should be submitted to the Office of Financial Aid and Veterans Services within the published deadline dates. Any appeal submitted after a deadline date has passed will go into the next review cycle.
- ❖ The Vice President of Student Services or his/her designee will consider appeals and the decision will be final. Students will be notified through their SPCC e-mail of appeal decisions.
- ❖ While awaiting a decision, students are expected to pay their balances or set up a payment plan.
- ❖ If approved, any eligible financial aid will be applied to the student account and/or refunded to the student according to the published Financial Aid Calendar Disbursement Dates.
- ❖ **Students receiving appeal approval will remain eligible for financial aid funding if they meet all requirements of the established individual Graduation Plan, which may include completing only courses required for graduation, maintaining a 2.5 semester GPA and 100% completion rate.**
