This class is for the officer who wants to better understand the dynamics of a deadly force encounter and to prepare themselves for that day.

Being Prepared For The Day offers an in-depth analysis of what occurs during and after an officer-involved shooting along with information to better prepare you before the incident can happen.

This 24 hour class utilizes personal interviews with more than thirty officers who have used deadly force, partner officers, spouses and significant others, criminal investigators, prosecutors, police administrators, defense attorneys, medical professionals, law enforcement trainers and media persons.
