

Cleaning and Disinfecting Protocol

Each classroom has been provided with cleaning and disinfecting supplies. Before you start your class, please follow the Protocol for Cleaning and Disinfecting Surfaces and Objects recommended by the CDC.

Protocol for Cleaning and Disinfecting Surfaces and Objects

1		Wear disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting surfaces. Gloves should be discarded after each cleaning. If reusable gloves are used, those gloves should be dedicated for cleaning and disinfection of surfaces for COVID-19 and should not be used for other purposes.
2		Clean surfaces and objects that are visibly soiled with detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.
3		Sanitize surfaces and objects that are touched often, such as desks, countertops, doorknobs, light switches, sinks, and hands-on learning items by spraying the surface with the disinfectant provided and drying the surface with a paper towel.
4		Sanitize computer keyboards, computer mice, manufacturing equipment, and electronic equipment that cannot be sprayed by using the provided sanitizing towels. If sanitizing towels aren't available, spray disinfectant on paper towels for the same purpose.
5		Clean hands immediately after surfaces have been cleaned.
