



# GENERAL INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

- BASIC RULES OF GUN SAFETY**
1. ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction
  2. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
  3. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use

***General Instructor Training is offered to Criminal Justice personnel planning to teach in any course mandated by either the Criminal Justice Education Training Standards Commission or the Sheriff's Education Training Standards Commission.***

#### REQUIREMENTS:

A minimum of a high-school diploma and four (4) years practical experience as a Criminal Justice Officer. Practical experience must be as a Criminal Justice officer or as an administrator or specialist in a field directly related to the Criminal Justice System.
