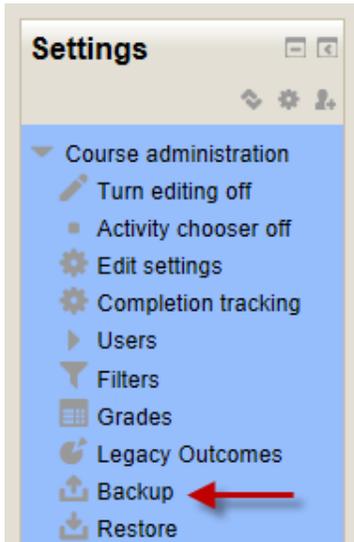


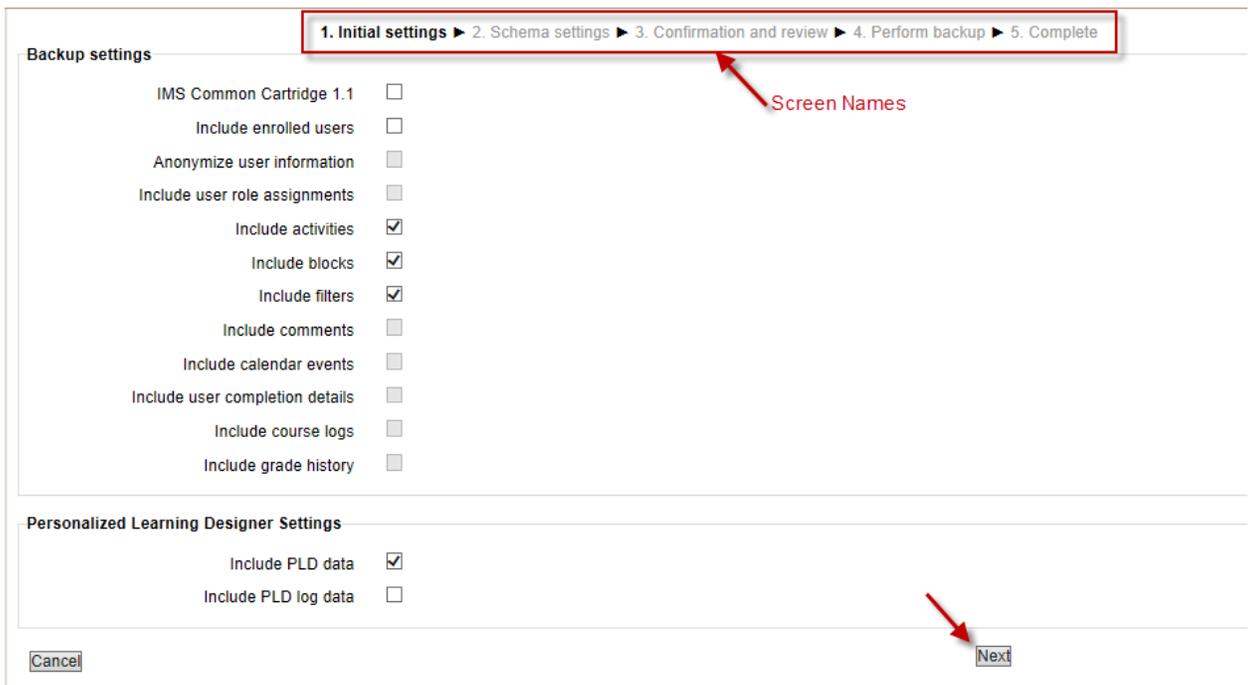
# How to Backup, Save, and Restore Moodle Courses and Clean up User Private Backup Area

## Backing up a Moodle Course

1. Login to <http://online.spcc.edu>
2. Select the course in which you would like to backup
3. In the **Settings** block, under **Course Administration**, click **Backup**



4. On the **Initial setting** screen, scroll down, and click the **Next** button



5. On the **Schema settings** Screen, scroll down, and click the **Next** button, again

- On the **Confirmation and review** screen, scroll down, and click **Perform backup**  
At this point, please be patient. It takes varying amounts of time, depending on the size of the course. You will eventually get the screen below

- Click **Continue**. Your file will be listed in your “User private backup area”

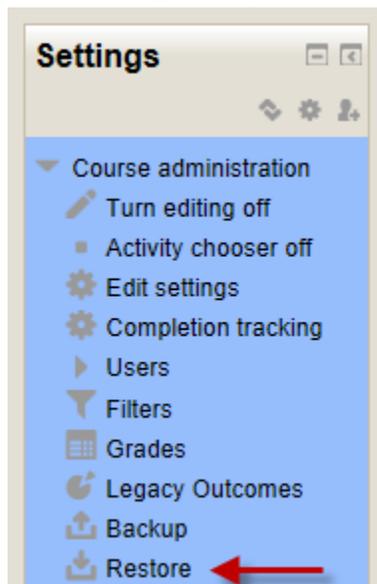

### Saving a Moodle Course

- Verify the Filename and Date/Time, and click **Download** (it is recommended to do this at the end of each semester)
- Click **Save As** in the popup window at the bottom of the screen, and save in desired location  
NOTE: This step may vary depending on the browser (e.g., Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari)

### Restoring a Moodle Course

- Go into the course in which you want to restore
- In the **Settings** block, under **Course Administration**, click **Restore**

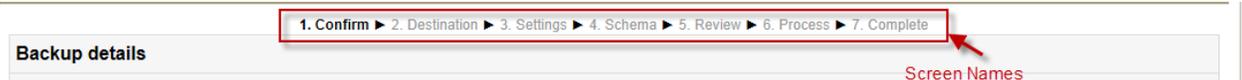


- Click the **Restore** button associated with the desired course in your User private backup area

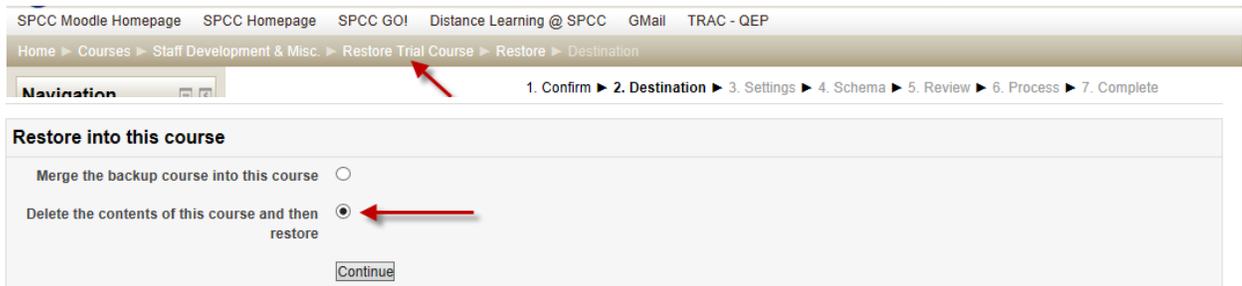

13. On the **Confirm** screen, scroll to the bottom and click **Continue**



14. On the **Destination** screen, verify that you are in the desired course. Under the **Restore into this course** section, select **Delete the contents of this course and then restore**, then press **Continue**

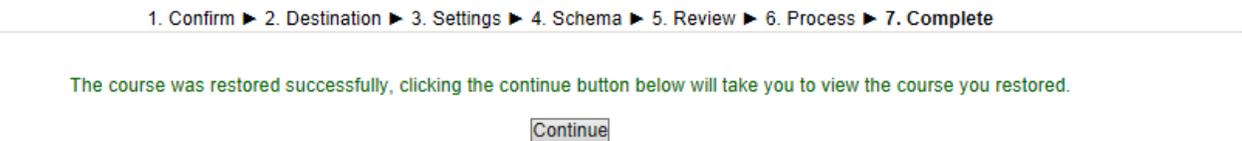


15. On the **Settings** screen, scroll down and click **Next**

16. On the **Schema** screen, scroll down and click **Next**

17. On the **Review** screen, scroll down and click **Perform restore**

At this point, please be patient. It takes varying amounts of time, depending on the size of the course. You will eventually get the screen below



18. Click **Continue**, and you will see your restored course

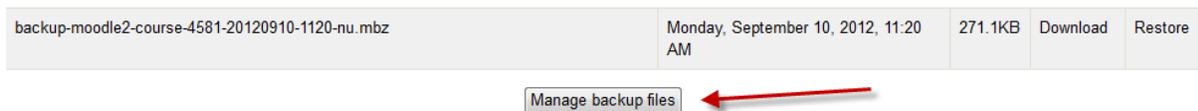
### Clean up User Private Backup Area

In order to save space on the Moodle server, please periodically clean up your “User private backup area”

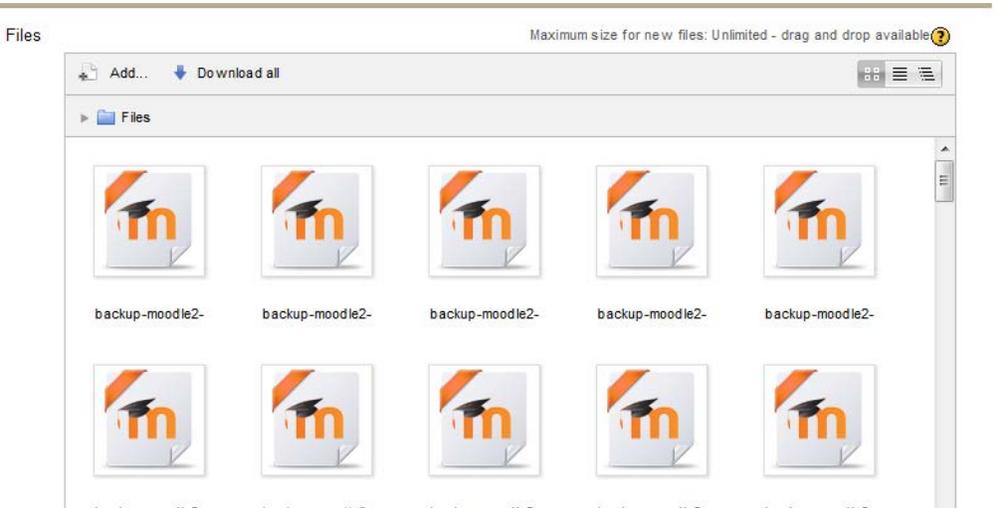
19. Login to one of your Moodle courses

20. In the **Settings** block, under **Course Administration**, click **Restore or Backup**

21. Click the **Manage backup files** button located under at the end of your User private backup area files



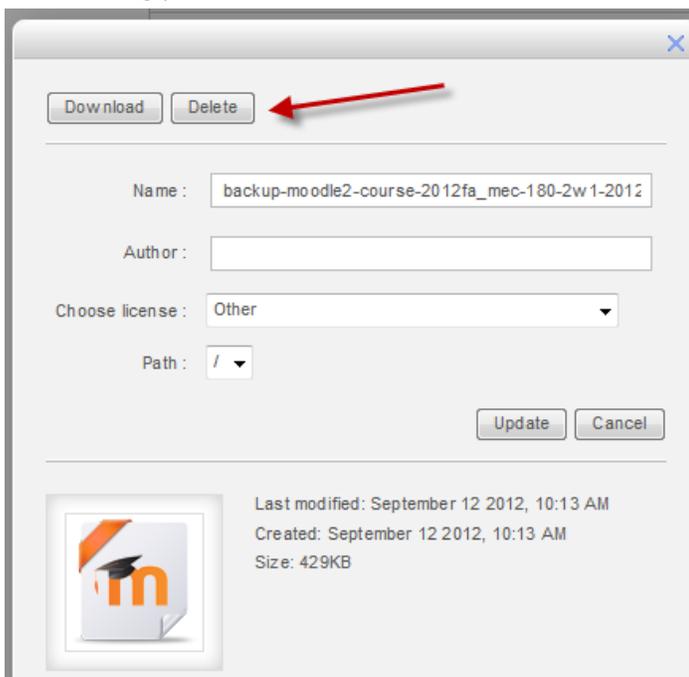
22. Your screen will look as follows



23. If you click the small list view box in the upper right-hand corner, it will organize the files so that you can see all of their names.



24. You may then either right or left click on any file that you no longer need, which will give you a box allowing you to delete the file. See below:



25. Please delete anything you no longer need in order to save space.
