

TITLE: SPCC Revere Literary Journal Club

Article One:

The name of the organization shall be **SPCC Revere Literary Journal Club**

Article Two:

ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to enrolled students at SPCC who agree to abide by the rules and policies of the Journalism Club. This means that they attend at least two meetings a semester, and commit to 5 hours a semester of community service.

Article Three:

MISSION

The primary purposes of the Revere Literary Journal Club is:

To create a yearly issue of the Revere, a literary journal focused on journalism, poetry, and visual arts. This process includes reporting, editing, lay-out and design. Club members will meet to present and discuss developments in Journalism (including photojournalism), and to plan activities that will carry their own expertise and interests for journalism to the students, faculty, and staff of SPCC.

Article Four:

OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Journalism Club will vote for 2 Co-Presidents, each serving a term of a semester.

Article Five:

MEETINGS

The Revere Literary shall meet once a month in the fall at a to-be-selected location. It will meet two-to-three times a month in the spring. The co-presidents shall preside over the meetings.

Article Six:

COMMENCEMENT OF A MEETING

Meeting will commence when a reasonable quorum is met which shall be 50% of the group registered members.

Article Seven:

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE:

The Revere Literary Club shall be subject to the rules, regulations, and policies of SPCC regarding student organizations.
