To film your video, please make sure that:

- Your video is 2-5 minutes in length
- You are dressed in business casual or business professional clothing
- No obscene languages or gestures
- You may not slander any other candidate that may be running

The submission will only be shared with the Director of Student of Life and Executive Board. Once submitted and reviewed, you will be given a chance to interview.
